Assembly Member Noreen Evans Announces Opposition to Measure A in Mendocino County

County Should Attract New Industries and Sustainable Jobs for the Masonite Corporation Site

Ukiah – State Assembly Member Noreen Evans announced her opposition today to Measure A in Mendocino County. Citing numerous problems with the ballot measure, Evan’s stated that she is “wholeheartedly opposed” to Measure A.

“Mendocino County needs development that contributes new, sustainable jobs without undermining existing businesses and community desires. The big-box retail plans formulated by DDR Corporation will not provide long-term, quality jobs for our community, they are unlikely to provide comprehensive healthcare for all employees and they won’t provide career opportunities for our youth. In fact, Measure A adds more traffic to our roads and jeopardizes local small businesses. Measure A slams the door on the public by giving license to the DDR Corporation to build and develop whatever it desires with no public input whatsoever.”

Evans joins a community that is united against Measure A. Also in opposition are the League of Women Voters, the North Bay Labor Council, a majority of the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors and majorities of the members of the City Councils in Fort Bragg, Ukiah and Point Arena.

Assembly Member Noreen Evans is running for State Senate to succeed Senator Patricia Wiggins. Senator Patricia Wiggins, Assembly Member Wesley Chesbro, Congressman Mike Thompson, Congresswoman Lynn Woolsey and President of the Senate Darrell Steinberg have all endorsed Evans.
