Assembly Member Noreen Evans to visit Mendocino County – 1st visit since declaring candidacy for State Senate in 2010

GUALALA – Assembly Member Noreen Evans is making her first visit to Mendocino County since announcing her campaign for state Senate in 2010 to succeed retiring State Senator Patricia Wiggins. She will be joining state Senator Pat Wiggins for a Meet and Greet Reception with the Democrats United for Progress. The event will take place on Saturday, September 19 from 2- 4 PM at the Gualala Community Center, 47950 Center Street. Congressman Mike Thompson, Congresswoman Lynn Woolsey, state Senator Patricia Wiggins and Assembly Member Wesley Chesbro have all endorsed Evans' candidacy.

As the Chair of the Assembly Budget Conference Committee, Evans understands the types of reform our legislative budget process needs, starting with elimination of the 2/3rds rule. Her campaign will be about advancing the cause of reform and creating sustainable jobs in a healthy environment.
